



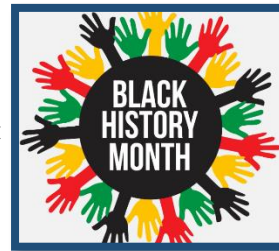

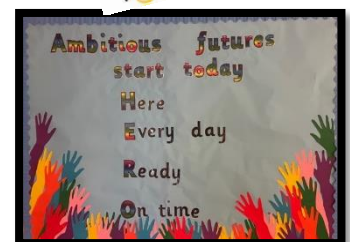
Parent & Carers Evening

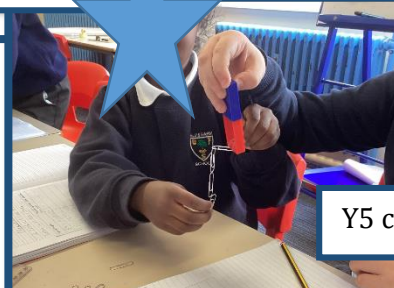
