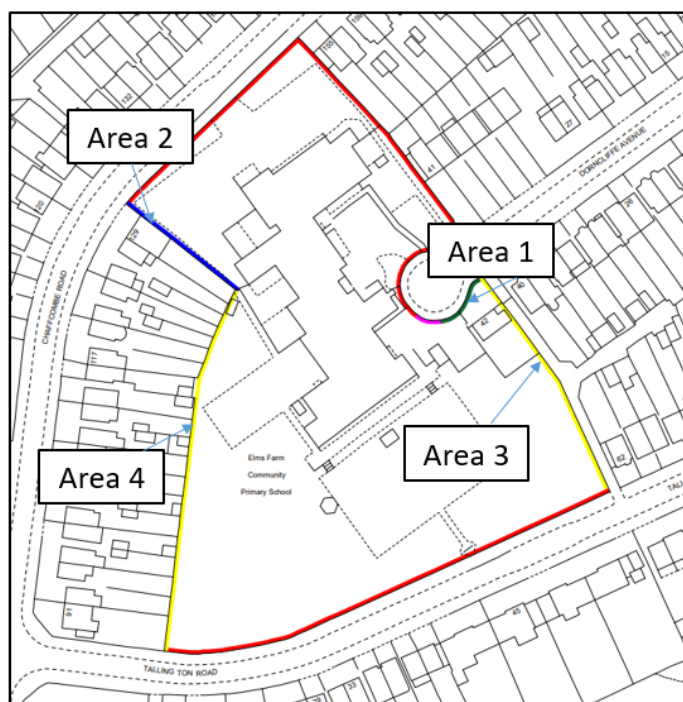

Dear Parents & Carers,

I am writing to share with you the planned work to improve the boundary fencing at Elms Farm Primary School.

The work is scheduled to begin on **Monday 3rd October**. It is scheduled to be completed in isolated areas to minimise any disruption to our school community. The detail of works being carried out are as follows:



Area 1: Bottom Car Park (Dorncliffe Avenue)

-Steel fencing & new gate to be fitted

Area 2: fencing to neighbour's garden by the stage (Y1/2 Playground)

-Wooden fencing to be fitted

Area 3: Fencing on the boundary of Forest School

Area 4: Fencing to edge of the playing field.

-Steel fencing 1m from neighbours' current fences & gate
