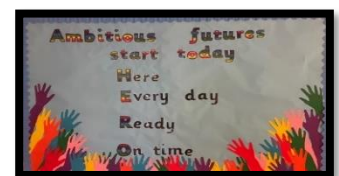
'Thank You'
