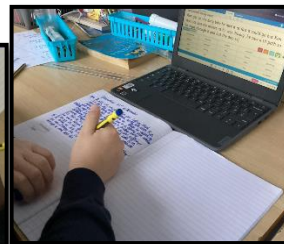
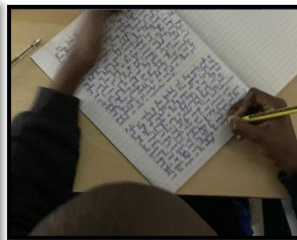
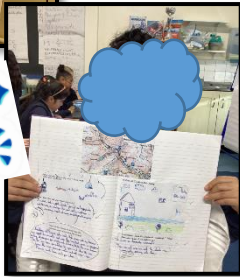
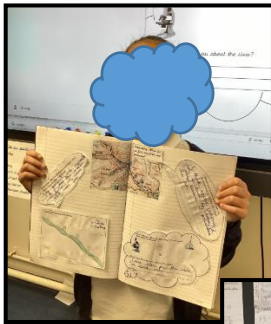


Ruby says... Article 29 Your education should help you use and develop your talents and abilities.

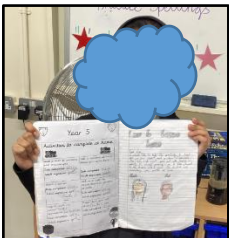
Jumpers & Cardigans-please help us!
