We have been amazed by the performances in school this week. The children performed incredibly well and their confidence and skill shone through. Thank you for joining us to watch them.



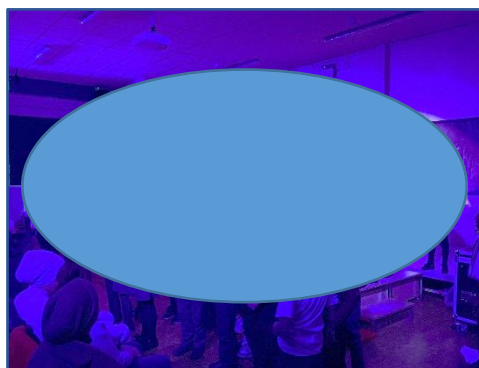
