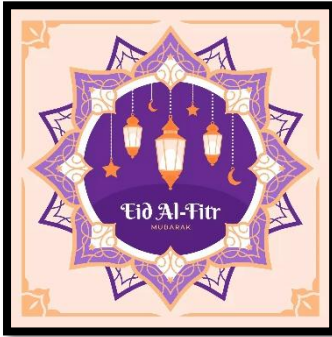

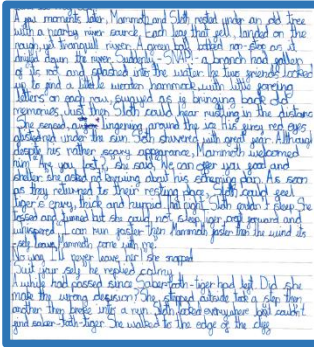

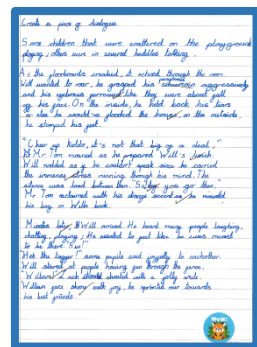

WHAT'S THE BEST DESIGN FOR A PAPER AIRPLANE?

A paper airplane, glider or helicopter lifts its ground track into the air and glides before descending or crashing to earth. This is because of the forces generated by air pressure and because of the shape of the wings. The well-known rule for creating good paper airplanes, gliders and helicopters means: **Streamline, wing and wing loading!**

How do we make the wings wider to create air resistance?

If I hold it up higher will it fly for longer? Why does the helicopter need to be weighted?
